2017 BOARD OF DIRECTOR GOALS

GENERAL

- 1. Participate in projects that 1) serve the largest number of District taxpayers, and 2) help the City of Lone Tree to make this the most desirable place to live in Colorado.
- 2. Financially assist the City of Lone Tree and Douglas County on street and streetscape projects with District property taxes while encouraging the City to cultivate new special district and other partners to share in these financial contributions to transportation and mobility projects that equally benefit *all* City of Lone Tree residents.

PROJECTS

- 3. Assist the City and Douglas County in County Line Road improvements west of I-25.
- 4. Construct the Yosemite median south of C-470 to Park Meadows Drive, considering a potential new median design that is less costly to maintain than our current "stacked stone design" and including elements of our current design along with appropriate landscaping as it fits into our budget.
- 5. Continue to work on future landscape improvements at the C-470 interchange on the south side.
- 6. Continue tuck point repairs on Lone Tree Parkway and monitor maintenance costs closely to determine how long repairs last. If repairs are determined to be too costly, we should consider a more "maintenance free design" that we can implement over time.
- 7. Continue our participation and support of the Lincoln Avenue pedestrian bridge.
- 8. Research the possibility of maintaining the brick fences that the City of Lone Tree currently maintains.
- 9. Research the possibility of utilizing "smart irrigation technology" for more efficient landscape maintenance water use.
